What is a Wiki?

Wiki is a Hawai'i an term meaning very fast or "Quickly". There are multiple types of Wiki technology that share common benefits, such as being accessible via the Web and allowing you and students to ...

- Quickly **edit/add content**.
- Quickly **track changes** through "history"
- Quickly **search** for content.
- Quickly **identify user contributions**.
- Quickly **see relationships (links) among content**.

The Faculty Wiki uses the "Media Wiki" technology, which is the same technology as *Wikipedia*.
